- Intent and rationale

- Skills and knowledge coverage audit

## Staff Responsibilities

- Staff to have responsibility for each curriculum area
- Every area of the national curriculum lead well and with a clear purpose through the subject vision
- Staff responsible for budget, ensuring progression of skills, skills and knowledge coverage etc.

## Breadth

- Every area of the curriculum well represented, giving a broad and balanced curriculum for every child
- What does the curriculum give in addition to national curriculum coverage
- What cultural capital have we identified as present (Gingerbread men)
- What cultural capital have we identified as being missing (Gingerbread men)

## Staff skills and confidence audit

- Identify areas of strength in staff knowledge, and skills. Utilise these to drive improvement.
- Identify areas for development in knowledge and skills, highlighting areas for CPD.

## Assessment

- Assessment of foundation subjects agreed
- Assessments monitored, moderation of assessments conducted

## Monitor Delivery

- Checking for consistency of delivery, expectations, coverage
