

Ashbourne Hilltop Primary Remote Learning Offer

We are delighted to be able to give details of our Home Learning offer for the latest school closure.

In line with government guidance we will be providing 3 hours of learning for pupils to engage with on a daily basis. We understand that it can be challenging to complete 3 hours each day, especially if there is more than one child in your household. For this reason, we ask that pupils complete as much as they can each day, prioritising Maths, English and Phonics sessions.

Communication with school

During this time, it is essential that we are able to communicate with all parents efficiently. We value the direct lines of contact that Class Dojo allows between school and home. We would like to continue using Class Dojo to communicate with parents about remote learning, to support with technical issues and other small matters that can be easily dealt with using small amounts of informal text.

If you have a concern regarding the emotional or physical wellbeing of your child or serious concerns regarding the complex needs of your child, then please contact the school through the office via telephone or email to arrange a time to discuss these matters more formally and in more detail. In this way we can direct enquiries to the correct member of staff and support more effectively.

Class Dojo is not an appropriate setting in which to conduct these very important and complex discussions.

Class Assemblies on Microsoft Teams

Our class teachers will host a weekly Teams meeting for those pupils who are not in school. Hopefully this contact will be a chance for teachers to catch up with children, but also for children to see each other and share an experience. Your child's class teacher will communicate via Class Dojo to let you know when the assembly will be and to send the link to the meeting. In order to ensure that these meetings are safe for our pupils and staff we will also be sending out an agreement between school and families with our procedures and rules around accessing the meetings.

Timetable

We will be sending our remote learning offer via a timetable through Class Dojo. This will have links to all online learning and explanations about the sessions to be delivered. The time table will not give specific times but will hopefully help families to find some structure through the day. Do not worry if you cannot follow this timetable. We are hoping it is a simple way to deliver our home learning information. On the timetable will be links to the relevant online learning videos and Google Classroom activities to make finding them easier.



Maths

We will be using White Rose maths for most of our maths in school and home learning offer. In this way the pupils at home will be receiving the same sessions as those in school. The lessons are delivered as videos on Vimeo and the pupils can respond using Google classroom.

The children all have their own logins to TTRockstars. This is a fun and engaging site where the children can practise times tables.

English

In English we will be using a mixture of our own Talk 4 Writing planning and sessions from The Oak Academy website. We hope to be able to use Google classrooms to respond to a piece of work in more detail on a weekly basis.

Reading

We will be setting a variety of reading challenges and activities using a host of online resources including Oxford Owl.

Blue and Red classes will receive daily phonics activities to complete. The majority of these will be games and activities on interactive websites such as Phonics play and Phonics Bloom. Links can be found on the weekly plan that will take you directly to all online activities.

There is also currently free access to the phonics play website which has a host of good phonics based games to practise key phonics skills.
