

## **Addendum for the Behaviour Policy**

**22<sup>nd</sup> May 2020**

### **COVID 19 Guidance**

Following our detailed risk assessment and to reduce the risks to staff the following guidance will be adhered to.

All children will have to adhere to strict social distancing rules and will be continually reminded to adhere to them.

Parents are informed of hygiene expectations and for the need to communicate this message in the home environment

If a child is asked several times to move a way and repeatedly does not listen, then we will speak to the parent at the end of the day and ask them to support in reminding them about the rules.

If a child does not follow the hygiene and handwashing guidelines we will ask parents to speak with them about the importance of this at the end of the day and we will continue to remind

If a child displays anti-social behaviour, for example, spits, hits, deliberately touches others, then the parent will be called and they will be asked to collect the child within 45 minutes and then the child will have to be home schooled for the foreseeable future.
