

Hilltop School Uniform

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in school organised events outside normal school hours.

The uniform is available from "Your School Uniform". This uniform comes with an embroidered school logo and can be delivered either to the purchasers home or into school.

The majority of necessary items are also available from local shops including supermarkets.

The uniform is explained in full in the policy document on the website, including links to local shops where the uniform can be purchased.

Uniform Policy

<u>Parents</u>

It is one of the responsibilities of parents to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and PE kit, and that it is clean, in good repair and that the child's name is written on all items.

Children who arrive at school wearing non-school uniform clothing will be loaned an appropriate item from our nearly new shop to wear for that day.

Parents will be contacted via letter or text message to broach the matter.

<u>Bags</u>

Nursery – Reception: Children should bring a book bag containing their reading book, reading record and a named drinks bottle. They should not bring a rucksack to school as we do not have space to store these in our classrooms.

Year 1 – Year 3: Children should bring a book bag containing their reading book, reading record and a fruit snack if they wish. They should not bring a rucksack to school as we do not have space to store these in our classrooms.

Year 4 – Year 6: Children should bring a book bag or small rucksack containing their reading book, reading record and a fruit snack if they wish.

Children arriving at school with the wrong bag will not be able to keep it with them due to space constraints.

<u>School Uniform List</u>

All children (Nursery – Year 6) should choose from:

- <u>Red sweatshirt</u>*, <u>cardigan</u>* or zip-up hoodie*
- plain white polo shirt*
- plain grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore
- red gingham dress
- grey or white socks
- grey or red tights
- shoes should be flat, black and appropriate for school. If trainers are worn these should be plain black and without logos. Your child should wear shoes which he or she can manage to do up independently.

In addition, zip-up fleeces and coats will be available from the online store.





<u>For PE all children (Reception – Year 6) should</u> <u>have:</u>

- red polo neck t-shirt with logo*
- <u>navy PE shorts</u>* or <u>navy track-suit bottoms</u>*
- white socks
- black trainers Velcro fastenings are appropriate for children who are struggling with laces

Items marked with a * above, which have the embroidered school logo, will soon be available to be purchased from an online retailer.

All children may bring a very small rucksack, preferably a drawstring bag, with their sports kit in on the days they are attending an afterschool sports club.
