






# Hilltop Primary Academy

Theme	Intent	Phonics	Maths
Our theme this term is Transport, Travel and Road Safety. Our overarching question we will be how do we travel from one place to another? To answer this, we will be looking at land, air and water transport, transport from the past, who helps us on the road and how we can cross a road safely.	This unit helps children learn about different types of transport, how people and goods travel, and the importance of staying safe.
