








Year 2 Learning – Autumn 1 2025

<p>Daily reading sessions support the children to build on their vocabulary, fluency and comprehension skills.</p>  <p>In our English lessons, we will be writing a biography about Henri Matisse and working on our setting descriptions!</p> 	<p>Place Value The children will work with numbers to 100, recognising tens and ones, partitioning, comparing, order and representing numbers using lots of practical resources.</p>  <p>Addition and subtraction: The children will add and subtract numbers to 100, use number bonds, apply place value and solve problems in different contexts.</p>	<p>Overarching question: Where do I live and what is special about it?</p>  <p>We will start by exploring a map of our local area before moving on to identify the countries of the United Kingdom and the surrounding seas. We will be exploring different types of farming in the UK, physical and human features and naming the continents and oceans of the world!</p>	<p>Overarching question: What do different parts of plants do?</p> <p>What plants grow near us? What do parts of a plant do? Do all trees look the same? Why do plants lose their leaves? What do I need to make seeds grow into plants?</p>
