


# Hilltop Primary Academy

## Year 2 Learning – Autumn 2 2025

English	Maths	History	Science
<p>Daily reading sessions support the children to build on their vocabulary, fluency and comprehension skills.</p> <p>In our English lessons, we will be writing a diary entry and a narrative based on the Great Fire of London.</p>  	<p><b>Addition and subtraction:</b> The children will add and subtract numbers to 100, use number bonds, apply place value and solve problems in different contexts.</p> <p><b>Shape:</b> The children will learn to identify and describe the properties of 2D and 3D shapes, including the number of sides, edges, vertices and faces and use this knowledge to compare, sort and make patterns with shapes.</p> 	<p><b>Overarching question:</b> Could the Great Fire of London ever happen again?</p> <p>In this unit, we will be exploring how the fire started and why it was so catastrophic. We will be comparing the fire brigade in 1666 and today, explaining why the fire was so significant and how we can learn from the past.</p> 	<p><b>Overarching question:</b> What are things made of?</p> <p>We will learn that objects are made from a variety of materials because they have different properties. We will be conducting an experiment to find out what material makes the best tent and how we can make the perfect sandcastle!</p>
