








Year 2 Learning – Spring 2 2026

<p>Daily reading sessions support the children to build on their vocabulary, fluency and comprehension skills.</p>  <p>In our English lessons, we will be writing a character description of a dragon and a letter from Paddington to Aunt Lucy about his adventures.</p> 	<p>Length and height In this unit, we will be measuring in centimetres and metres and comparing, ordering and using the four operations with lengths and heights.</p>  <p>Mass, capacity and temperature In this unit, we will be measuring and comparing mass, volume and capacity, applying the four operations to solve problems and exploring temperature.</p>	<p>Overarching question: Where did kings and queens live through time? We will be exploring the lives of important kings and queens from the past and we will learn why monarchs built castles. We will also examine how monarchs and castles have changed over time.</p> 	<p>Overarching question: Why do materials have different properties? In this unit, we will be exploring the properties of materials, how their shapes can be changed and how to plan and carry out a fair experiment. We will also learn how to collect results and decide whether they are reliable.</p>
